1. RACES/ARES Update
 - a. RACES and ARES are both Amateur Radio organizations that formally support the communities we live in. The RACES organization is part of Steele County Emergency Management and serves at the direction of the Steele County Emergency Management Director. ARES is organized by the American Radio Relay League (ARRL) and supports community groups outside of the Emergency Management domain.
 - b. Steele County operates a combined RACES/ARES organization in conjunction with OSCAR. This format allows the local Amateur Radio community to respond to a wide array of situations

with the least amount of confusion. Tom N0UW serves as the RACES Radio Officer and ARES Emergency Coordinator for Steele County.

- c. Tom N0UW is updating the list of individuals who will answer the call for assistance. Anyone who wants to be included in RACES/ARES notifications should contact Tom N0UW through the OSCAR email address.
- d. New RACES credentials are being issued. Previously issued Steele County badges with CERT, SKYWARN, RACES, ARES, OSCAR, or combined designations are no longer valid. Tom will take new pictures along with your current information to obtain a new RACES badge. Information and pictures can be updated at any OSCAR or SKYWARN meeting.
