N0UW worked with a trap vertical out at the Crane Creek site. (The old Field Day site for many years) He also shared a Step-IR website for good info on radials.

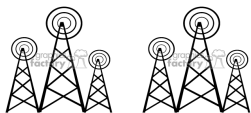
Meeting was adjourned at 9:58am.

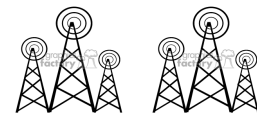
